**ENTRY FEE:** \$1 per exhibit to a maximum of \$5. Seniors and juniors free.

**PRIZES:** Ribbons will only be awarded in junior sections or junior classes  
Certificates and sponsor prize money.

### SPECIAL BY-LAWS FOR VEGETABLES

1. All exhibits to be delivered on **Thursday evening, March 7, 2019 between 6:30pm and 9.00pm** or between 7.30am and 9.30am on Friday, March 8, 2019.
2. **Judging to start at 10.00am on Friday, March 8, 2019.**
3. All exhibits must have been grown by the exhibitor or a member of his or her household.
4. Junior is an exhibitor 17 years of age and under.
5. **STANDARD UNIT:** A standard unit for any particular vegetable is shown in vegetable classes eg:  
3 carrots, 12 beans, 1 long cucumber, 3 apple cucumbers.
6. **AOV:** Any other variety.
7. ***Entries can be collected from 6.00pm on day of show, ie Saturday, March 9, 2019. Entries and prizemoney not collected will be forfeited.***



**NB:** Entry forms can be delivered to the Cooma Multi-function Pavilion, Cooma Showground, between 10am and 2pm on Friday, March 1, 2019 or mailed to Dorothy Whiting, PO Box 1252, Cooma NSW 2630 by Thursday, March 7, 2019.

### GENERAL HINTS ON EXHIBITING VEGETABLES

Vegetables must be true to type. A variety may have several types but entry shall be all of the same type. The size, shape and colour should be identical.

**TOPS:** Vegetables such as carrots should be shown with the tops cut back leaving about 75 -100mm of the top on. This should be fresh, without wilting or other damage.
