SPECIAL BY-LAWS FOR FIBRECRAFT ENTRIES

- 1. All exhibits must be delivered to the multi-function centre on Wednesday 11th March 2020 between 8:00am and 6:00pm.**
2. Each exhibit must be the work of the exhibitor (with the exception of class 24).
3. Exhibits may have been washed or used; however, they must not be soiled and must be of acceptable standard (at the discretion of the stewards and judges).
4. Exhibits may be lightly pressed and is recommended.
5. Feature stitch for 2021: Celtic Weave Stitch (crochet stitch)
- 6. Entries can be collected from 6pm onwards on day of show, Saturday, March 14, 2020.**

Entries and/or prizemoney not collected on this day will be forfeited.

SPINNING

A staple of original fibre, plied and skeined, to be attached to each entry, not less than 50g.

13. HANDSPUN ANY FIBRE from a commercially prepared fleece.
14. HANDSPUN MERINO FIBRE direct from fleece, prepared by exhibitor.
15. HANDSPUN ANY OTHER FIBRE direct from fleece, prepared by exhibitor.

HANDSPUN FIBRE ARTICLE

Each article to be crafted by exhibitor and a staple of original fibre to be attached to each entry.

16. HANDKNITTED or CROCHETED ARTICLE using handspun fibre.

FELTING

17. ANY ARTICLE.

JUNIORS

12 years and under. Please include age of exhibitor

Exhibitor must not have won a prize at any show.

24. ANY ARTICLE made by more than one person. Entry may be a combination of any of the above classes with or without surface decoration. Please specify person's names and contribution made by each person.

FEATURE STITCH

25. ANY ARTICLE made featuring crocheted Roman Stripe (Knitted).
