- All entries for the showjumping will be through Global entries.
- Stalls may be reserved for the duration of the event. The cost is \$20 for large stalls and \$10 for small stalls. The rodeo yards may also be booked. The cost is \$10 for the duration.
- Camping is available with limited power on the grounds. Camping should be booked through global and the cost is \$25 per night per vehicle.

- This Showjumping Competition is conducted under ASC Peak Body Showjumping Rules. All Exhibitors must complete and sign an Individual Waiver Form and compete at their own risk.
- The show does not carry insurance for individual competitors. Competitors are encouraged to have their own cover through membership of a relevant organisation.
- EA rules will apply in all classes.
- Horses and Riders competing in classes 1.05m and above must carry current full EA registration
- Horses may have two starts per day.
- Draws and results for all events will be published on global. Live scoring will be in operation
- The Tommy Turnbull Memorial Shield will be run in conjunction with Class 1 on Friday. Riders must be under the age of 18 and be resident in the SMRC district.
