SPECIAL BY-LAWS FOR HANDCRAFT ENTRIES

1. Entry forms must be completed by **Friday March 1, 2024 (NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED)** and can be completed online at www.coomashow.com.au *or* delivered to Cooma Visitors Centre between February 1 2024 and March 1 2024, 7 days a week between 9am to 3pm *or* posted to PO Box 809 Cooma NSW 2630.
2. **All exhibits must be delivered to the multi-function centre on Wednesday 6 March 2024 between 8:00am and 6:00pm.**
3. Each exhibit must be the work of the exhibitor and completed in the last 12 months unless otherwise stated in section.
4. An exhibit shown at the 2023 Cooma Show will not be eligible for judging.
5. Porcelain doll/s: Costumes, hats and accessories (except for shoes) must be the work of the entrant.
6. Exhibitors must provide stands for their porcelain doll/s; suitable stand for plates and plaques are provided by the show society.
7. **BEGINNER:** Less than 12 month's experience; **OPEN:** More than three (3) years' experience
8. **AGE CLASSIFICATIONS:** JUNIORS: six (6) years and under; 12 years and under; 17 years and under; ADULTS: 18 years and over; SENIORS: 60 years and over.
9. **Open all adult exhibitors may enter, professional is for a person who teaches, sells or conducts a business.**
10. Ceramic entries with loose parts must be securely fastened with tape, not glue, to withstand handlings. No felt on base unless a chess piece or bookend.
11. Entries in the ceramics classes must be kiln-fired and come from moulds.
12. Decorative painting may be applied on any surface including wood, metal, fabric, ceramics or any suitable surface.
13. Any type of identifying signature on an entry must be covered before judging commences.

14. Entries can be collected from 6pm onwards on the day of the show, Saturday, March 9 2024. Entries and/or prizemoney not collected on this day will be forfeited.
